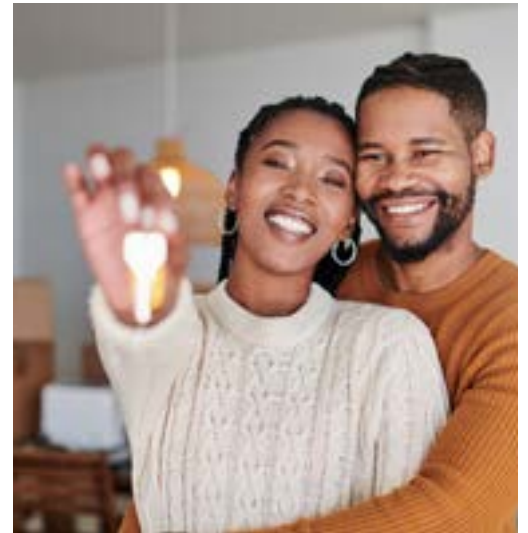
WHA RESIDENTS CONTINUE TO ACHIEVE THEIR GOALS

HEALTH AND WELLNESS SCREENINGS

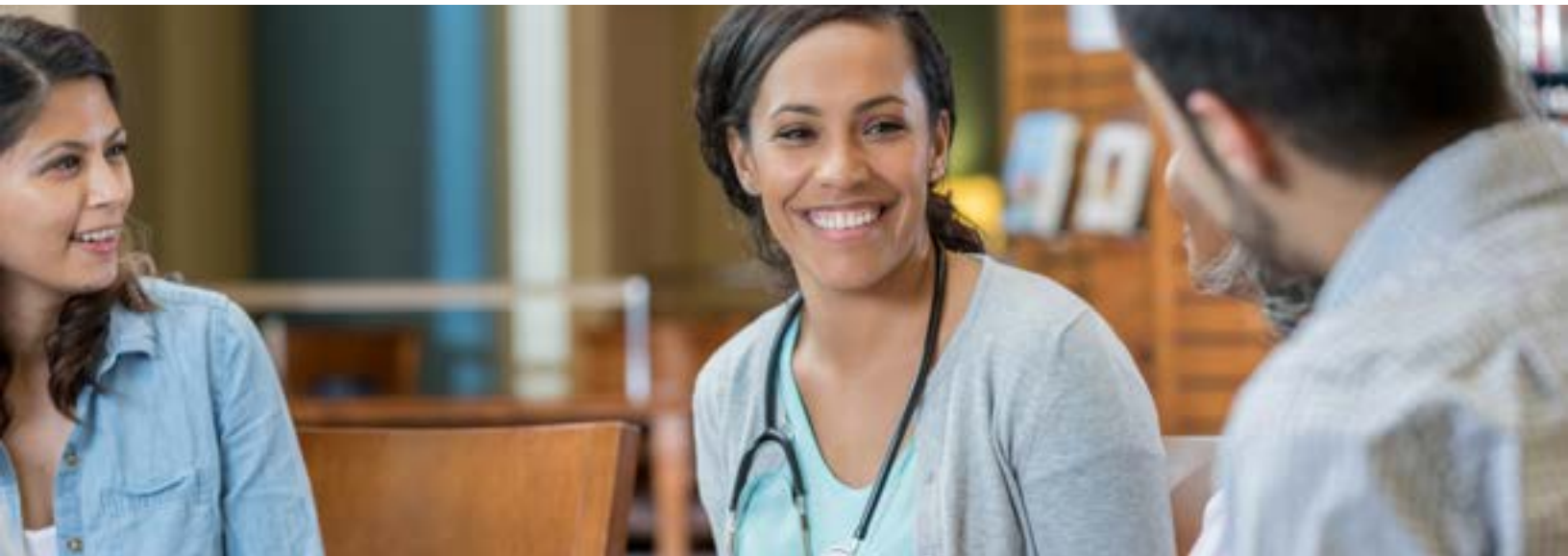

CHANGES TO COVID-19 TESTING ACCESS

December 28, 2022 was the last day Curative provided COVID-19 testing through their partnership with the Delaware Division of Public Health. There are other COVID-19 testing options available in Delaware:

UTILITY ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LIHEAP)

Delaware has two components to LIHEAP for helping income-eligible Delawareans during the winter months with their energy assistance needs.

FUEL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FAP)

Fuel Assistance Program (FAP) provides help with home energy bills for both homeowners and renters from October 1st through March 31st. FAP grants for qualifying income-eligible families can be used for electricity, natural gas, propane, wood, kerosene or coal.

CRISIS INTERVENTION PROGRAM (CIP)

Crisis intervention Program (CIP) is offered during winter months. Families participating in this program must provide proof of crisis (i.e., shut off notice, no money to pay or out of fuel) in addition to income eligible to qualify.

WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (WAP)

WAP helps income-eligible Delaware renters and homeowners lower their energy bills through weather proofing and increasing the energy efficiency of their homes at NO COST. An assessment by a WAP professional will be completed to identify what enhancements, such as weather stripping or insulation, can be provided to reduce your energy bills.

WATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Delaware Division of Public Health (DPH) Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP), provides assistance to eligible households to pay water and wastewater bills.

- Prevent disconnection of household water services
- Help reduce current household water bills

FREE NARCAN ACCESS TRAINING

Delaware Health & Social Services, Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (DSAMH) offers free statewide Narcan (Naloxone) medicine. Narcan is a medication that is effective in reversing the effects of an opioid overdose in an individual.



LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- How to recognize and effectively respond to an opioid overdose
- What is Naloxone, how to store & to administer, relevant laws, and legislation around Naloxone, including the statewide standing order

Training sessions are offered for both individuals training for the first time and POD (Point of Distribution). Upon completion of training, participants are eligible to receive a FREE Opioid Rescue Kit.

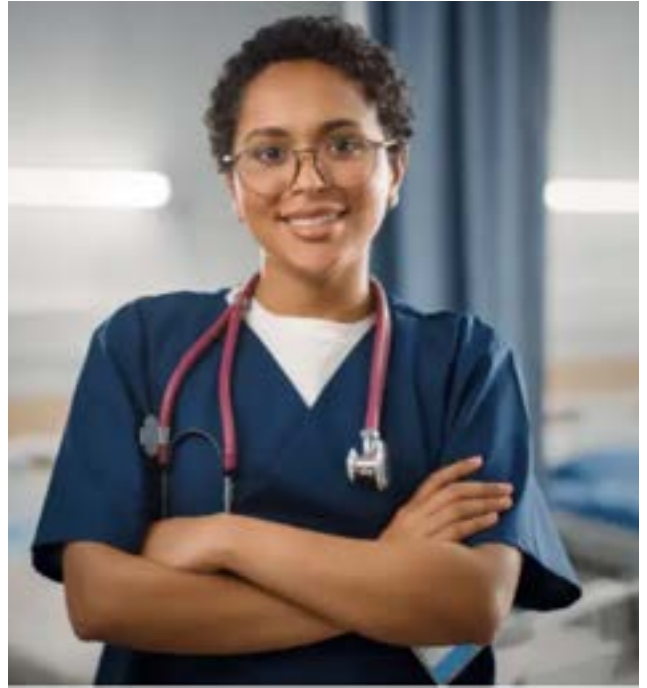

NEW VETERAN INDICATOR FOR DRIVER LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD

Veterans of the United States Armed Forces, or the National Guard can add the new Veteran Indicator to their driver license or identification card. This new indicator eliminates the need for veterans to carry a separate card or official discharge forms in order to prove their service.

The Veteran Indicator designation is available to any Delaware Veteran that served in the U.S. military and was honorably discharged. To obtain the Veteran Indicator, a valid Delaware driver's license or identification card is required and proof of military service by presenting an



Original document of a military ID, NGB-22, DD-214, DD-256, honorable discharge certificate, or valid out-of-state driver license with veteran designation. Veterans who are renewing, changing their address, or purchasing a duplicate driver license or identification card may add the indicator at no additional charge at any DMV location. Applicable fees for the above services will apply, but you will not be charged an additional \$10.00 to add the Veteran indicator.
