WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY & CITY OF WILMINGTON RECEIVE \$50 MILLION HUD GRANT

On August 1, 2023, Deputy Secretary Adrianne Todman, of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) awarded the Wilmington Housing Authority and the City of Wilmington the \$50 million Choice Neighborhood Implementation Grant. Wilmington Housing Authority was one of eight housing authorities nationwide awarded this grant and will use it to add over 550 new mixed-income rental homes to the Imani Village community, which currently includes 74 apartments for low-income families, seniors, veterans, and individuals with disabilities.

During the press, Deputy Secretary Todman emphasized that the grant is designed for communities, like the City of Wilmington, with a strong plan for neighborhood redevelopment. She also stated that the grant focuses on three areas; people, community, and housing. The application for the award was the culmination of four years of collaborative planning between residents, as well as community and business organizations. The Choice award will also be used to expand the Kingswood Community Center's EMPOWER Program, which provides supportive services that help to improve residents' quality of life.

The Wilmington Housing Authority and the City of Wilmington are proud to be the recipient of this prestigious award as it will bring more opportunities for the community, including helping to support local businesses and create jobs in the neighborhood.

"This award is going to allow us to accelerate the housing project we have planned.," stated WHA Executive Director, Ray Fitzgerald. "We're going to be able to get the project done in less than 10 years, which is remarkable." The Choice Neighborhood Implementation Grant will result in more than 700 homes being completed by 2031.

RENEWALS HAVE BEGUN FOR MEDICAID & CHIP COVERAGE


The Annual Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) eligibility reviews went into effect on April 1, 2023. Information on file will be used to decide if family members still qualify for Medicaid or CHIP coverage. Most children can still be covered through CHIP.

If more information is needed to make a coverage decision, a renewal letter will be mailed, so it's important for anyone who has moved, contact information should be updated. There are 3 easy steps families can take to prepare for the renewal process:

- 1. Update contact information
- 2. Check mail
- 3. Complete renewal form (if they get one)

Report any name changes or contact updates (email/mail address, phone numbers) by calling the Change Report Center (302) 571-4900, Option 2, by fax (302) 571-4901, or through your Delaware ASSIST Account.





POSTPARTUM MEDICAID EXTENDED TO 12 MONTHS

Those enrolled in Medicaid will be eligible to receive 12 months of ongoing postpartum health care coverage beginning on the date their pregnancy ends, regardless of the reason, through 12 months after the last date of the pregnancy. They will remain eligible for ongoing postpartum health care coverage even if certain changes occur that may affect eligibility.



- A government-issued ID; OR


