Public Allies Delaware is currently recruiting for their 10-month training program. To be eligible for the program, applicants must be:

- A U. S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- 17 years or older
- Possess a high school diploma or GED
- Be willing to commit to the high expectation of the program, which includes an apprenticeship at a non-profit, leadership training, and a community-building team service project

Program participants will receive a \$22,000 living allowance, health insurance, assistance with childcare costs, forbearance of qualified student loans, and a \$6,495 education award.
