WHA HELPING FAMILIES AQUIRE AFFORDABLE HOUSING

Wilmington Housing Authority's (WHA) Executive Director, Ray Fitzgerald, was a panelist of Investing in Our Neighborhoods, at Opportunity LIVES Here Symposium on November 1, 2023. The Symposium was coordinated by State Senator Darius Brown to bring together leaders, organizations, and community members to discuss strategies to create a pathway for economic development to Wilmington, Delaware's 2nd District. Opportunity LIVES Here promises to transform the Three Rivers area into an economically, culturally, and socially thriving community.

During the panel, Mr. Fitzgerald stated that "we must be creative to provide opportunities for affordable housing to our working families that are still facing this barrier. WHA knows that we cannot keep doing the same thing and have different results, therefore WHA has made partnerships to accomplish their focus of strengthening the community."

Under Mr. Fitzgerald's leadership WHA has expanded partnerships and initiatives to significantly increase the opportunities for low-income families in the city of Wilmington. Imani Village project and YouthBuild program are just a few of WHA's initiatives to help provide affordable housing opportunities to Wilmington families and establish programs to support achieve self-sufficiency.

During the panel, Mr. Fitzgerald also discussed several efforts by WHA's non-profit affiliate, the Delaware Affordable Housing Group (DAHG). DAHG's initiatives will result in 40 abandoned properties being transformed into affordable homes for Wilmington families by the end of 2024. DAHG's Premier Rapid Housing Placement Team provides intensive case management to families seeking housing and has assisted over 50 families in the Housing Choice Voucher program in obtaining affordable homes.

WHA was honored to be part of the conversation and look forward to future initiatives developed from Symposium attendees and panelists leading to more affordable housing for our Wilmington communities.

WHA'S RESIDENT SERVICES TEAM HOST ANNUAL JOB FAIR WAS A SUCCESS


The WHA Resident Services Team hosted their annual Mini Job Fair on Wednesday, November 15, 2023, from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM at Crestview Apartments in Wilmington. This event is offered to WHA residents as well as the general community. In addition, the WHA Resident Services Team coordinated transportation for residents to get to and from the job fair. Nearly 100 WHA residents and community members attended the job fair to connect with hiring agents as well as education and training programming. Almost 20 vendors, including Veterans Multi-Service Center, Department of Labor, Forman Mills, Delaware Center for Distance Adult Learning, YouthBuild and Westside Family Health attended the event.

The variety of employment sectors and status were well received by the attendees. WHA resident and job fair attendee, Kearra Slaton, currently works with WHA Resident Services and is in the process of transitioning career paths. Ms. Slaton expressed is interested in a career in the healthcare field. She stated that the information provided was helpful and enlightening to gain a better understanding of the options available in the field.

Vendors were pleased with the traffic and interest being expressed by attendees. The Department of Labor commented that their free GED program along with a \$500.00 stipend was also of interest to several individuals. Forman Mills' recruiter highlighted their seasonal positions in addition to the full and part-time given many of the attendees had an interest in that level of employment.

Two job fair attendees were hired on the spot through Shop Rite. Applications were accepted by Forman Mills and other vendors for attendees to be called in for interviews at the employer location.

YOUTHBUILD PARTICIPANT SPOTLIGHTS

Wilmington Housing Authority YouthBuild is thrilled to highlight three remarkable journeys of YouthBuild participants as they immerse themselves in employment placement and work experiences. Here is a glimpse into their accomplishments for transportation and document imaging roles.

Jerry Nova

Jerry Nava was referred by a family member to YouthBuild. Although Jerry had recently graduated from high school, he had not settled into a career path. YouthBuild helped guide his direction to a career in commercial driving. Through participation in the YouthBuild Program, Jerry has earned his Commercial Driver's License (CDL) from Dawn Institute. Not only was he the youngest in his class, but Jerry also graduated 3rd in the class. After graduating with his certification, Jerry earned a full-time job with Goodwill Staffing Services and was assigned to Department of Health and Social Services' (DHSS) Community Partner Support Unit's Transportation Team. Jerry is well on his way to self-sufficiency and continues to strive toward his goals of gaining CDL related employment, becoming financially stable, homeowner, owning a vehicle, and eventually his own truck. Jerry said that he has been inspired to be an entrepreneur, by his father who is a local business owner.

Annabelle Cain

When asked what YouthBuild has meant to her, Annabelle said "being in YouthBuild has given me the opportunity to not only believe in myself, but to know my struggle is temporary. Since I've been in YouthBuild, I've gotten a great paying full-time job, childcare, moved into a new home, GREAT mental support, and friends I care so much about."

Annabelle was referred by her DHSS case manager due to her being unemployed with no prospects for employment or furthering her education. Initially, Annabelle struggled with the motivation to attend YouthBuild's introductory course, Mental Toughness, but she stated her case manager called weekly to make sure she was attending and participating to successfully complete the course. Although, there have been challenges, Annabelle is learning to make better choices and do what is necessary to reach her goal of employment so that she can continue to provide a home or her family Annabelle's journey has her attending classes at James Groves High School to attain her high school diploma to then lead her into a career certification path of her choosing.

Grisellys Marrero-Rosa

When asked to describe, Grisellys, or Gigi as she is known in her YouthBuild cohort, Case Manager, Damon Hopkins said she is a "ball of fire and a picture of resilience." Anyone that meets her can see this description come to life immediately. Gigi had a rocky start when she first came to YouthBuild. Since this past September 2023, she has been on track and motivated to complete her GED at James Groves High School, secured part-time employment with the assistance of YouthBuild, and secured housing for her and her child. as a Wilmington Housing Authority Document Imagine Technician. Gigi currently works part-time as a Document Imaging Technician for the Wilmington Housing Authority. Her next steps include obtaining full-time employment. Additionally, she has a goal of owning a home and a vehicle. Gigi stated that the support she receives from YouthBuild is more than just help, it feels like a family. She said, "Whatever you need they will help you; you name it and they help you - food, housing, rental down payments." Gigi also stated about her participation in YouthBuild, "When I walked into YouthBuild I felt like a nobody but I'm walking out being more than just a somebody."

SUCCESSFUL HOUSING PLACEMENT

The Delaware Affordable Housing Group (DAHG) Premier Rapid Housing Placement Team provides housing placement assistance to individuals in the City of Wilmington. They support their clients in finding affordable, safe, sanitary, and decent homes for themselves and their families. Their services include case management, barrier assistance, and rental navigation services.

The DAHG Premier Rapid Housing Placement Team provides these services to families in a large part through their landlord partnerships. They support clients and landlord partners in finding appropriate matches between clients and vacant affordable homes. Benefits provided to landlords include tenant recruitment to fill their vacancies, property inspections to ensure units align with local safety codes and secure payments through a portal for landlords to receive monthly rental payments from tenants.

During November 2023, Premier Rapid Housing Placement Team completed 14 housing placements, which results in over 50 placements in 2023 year-to-date. All but one of the referrals were generated through Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) housing voucher programing, the one was through WHA, but that client was self-payment of their rent.

The end of summer led to Ms. Gineen Gordon being "happy and feeling soooo blessed" after securing housing for her and her child after nearly eight months of homelessness. Housing Locator, Briana Sellers, assisted Ms. Gordon over a 3-week period to secure housing. Ms. Gordon stated that she was extremely happy with Ms. Sellers' commitment to communicating information to her. When Ms. Gordon also stated that Ms. Sellers went above and beyond to keep in contact with her when she lost her cell phone.

Breisha Tucker

In August, Brenisha Tucker was referred to the DAHG Premier Rapid Housing Placement Team from Delaware 211, seeking housing for her and her children. During her search, there were times she became discouraged, but her Housing Locator, Joseph Boatwright, continued to encourage her during the search until final placement. On November 17, 2023, Ms. Tucker received her keys and according to Mr. Boatwright, she was "all smiles." In addition to the housing placement, Mr. Boatright assisted Ms. Tucker with securing furniture, some of which were beds for she and her children to have a more comfortable rest in their new home.




YOUTHBUILD PROGRAM IS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS




