## **IMPORTANT UPDATE: NEW CONTACT PROCESS FOR HCV CLIENTS & PARTICIPANTS**

To better serve our residents and clients, the Wilmington Housing Authority's Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Unit has made important updates to how you connect with your assigned Housing Specialist.

Effective August 1, 2025, HCV clients and participants will no longer be able to use the unit mailboxes previously listed as [hcvre-exams@whadelaware.org](mailto:hcvre-exams@whadelaware.org) or [hcvmoves@whadelaware.org](mailto:hcvmoves@whadelaware.org).

Instead, Housing Specialists have been assigned caseloads based on the unit they manage and clients' last names in alphabetical order. This change ensures that each client is directly connected to the Housing Specialist responsible for their case, providing more personalized support and timely assistance.

## WHA AWARDED 28 NEW TENANT PROTECTION VOUCHERS BY HUD

This award is part of HUD's nationwide investment of more than \$185 million to provide nearly 14,500 Tenant Protection Vouchers to Public Housing Authorities across the country. These vouchers are designed to assist families impacted by housing transitions such as property sales, contract expirations, mortgage prepayments, and demolition or revitalization initiatives. WHA is deeply grateful to HUD for selecting us for this critical funding, which expands our ability to provide safe, stable, and affordable housing opportunities to Wilmington families in need. This award represents another important step in our mission to ensure housing security and improve quality of life for the residents we proudly serve.

## SPOTLIGHT ON WHA'S NEW SECURITY MANAGER: NATHAN

Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) is pleased to welcome Nathan as our new Security Manager. With over a decade of experience in security and safety management, Nathan began his career at just 18 years old. He was drawn to the field by its stability and broad application across industries—from protecting new construction sites to overseeing high-demand environments. His background includes working in New York City at a disaster shelter, where he supported residents from diverse backgrounds facing a wide range of challenges. Nathan saw the Security Manager role at WHA as an opportunity to expand his leadership experience in a position that directly serves and strengthens communities.



In his role, Nathan oversees safety for all WHA properties, ensuring both staff and residents are protected through the coordination of contracted security teams. He attends staff and resident meetings, and in his first six months, is focused on learning WHA's policies and procedures to effectively enforce operations. Nathan plans to host safety meetings at each WHA property, bringing in community partners like the Wilmington Police Department and Wilmington Fire Department to share practical safety tips. He stresses the importance of participation in drills, such as fire evacuations, so residents are well-prepared if an emergency occurs.

For Nathan, "community safety" means everyone looks out for one another. Raised with the belief that "it takes a village to raise a child," he emphasizes the role residents play in maintaining safe neighborhoods through the "see something, say something" approach. "It's your home, and you want it to be a peaceful place," he says. Nathan wants residents to know that he is approachable and ready to listen. His door is always open to concerns, ideas, and conversations that will help make WHA communities safer for all.

This program may be eligible at no cost through the participant's health insurance provider. Self pay cost is \$429.00, with financial assistance and payment plans available.

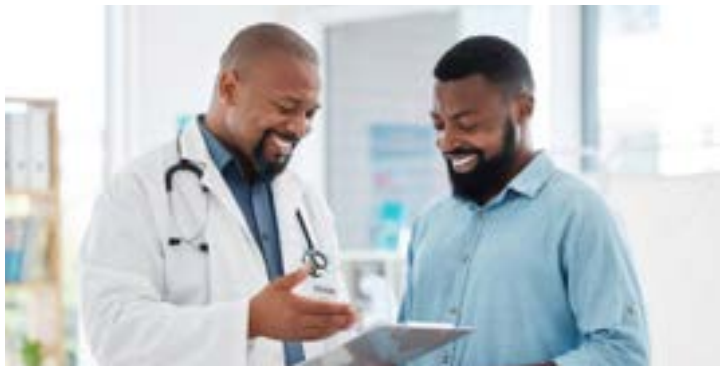
