WHA HOUSING MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE TEAMS CELEBRATE OUTSTANDING FOURTH QUARTER REAC SCORES!

The Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) is proud to recognize the exceptional performance of our Housing Management and Maintenance teams following the recent inspections conducted by HUD's Real Estate Assessment Center (REAC). These inspections, completed under the National Standards for the Physical Inspection of Real Estate (NSPIRE) model, underscore WHA's commitment to ensuring safe, high-quality housing for our residents.

What Are REAC Scores and Why Do They Matter?

REAC scores are numerical assessments reflecting the physical condition of properties based on inspections by HUD-certified inspectors. These scores range from 0 to 100, with higher scores signifying better conditions.

REAC scores play a pivotal role in:

- 1. **Tenant Well-being:** Supporting safe, healthy living environments.
- 2. Property Management: Providing performance benchmarks for ongoing maintenance.
- 3. Funding: Influencing the funding WHA receives for future improvements.

Exceptional Results from WHA Inspections

This quarter, REAC inspections were conducted at Crestview, Southbridge, and the New Village of East Lake. The results speak volumes about the dedication and hard work of WHA's teams:

- Crestview: Scored an impressive 89, earning High Performer status.
- Southbridge: Achieved a solid 83, also recognized as a High Performer.
- New Village of East Lake: Secured a commendable 79, a Standard Performer score.

The Delaware Affordable Housing Group (DAHG) is the nonprofit affiliate to WHA. The Housing Locators on DAHG's Premier Rapid Housing Placement Team (PRHPT) had a stellar fourth quarter of 2024.

The team assisted 40 families in locating housing in fourth quarter of 2024 and 150 total placements for 2024. Seven placements were residents transitioning from Riverside Family Development, one was a YouthBuild participant that aged out of Foster Care, and another was a family that were self-pay. Clients are referred to the team through several different sources, including WHA's Section 8 Team. Our team is committed to helping families identify affordable and safe housing statewide. Most clients had housing vouchers, and all clients were pleased to have assistance in their journey.

NEW CASTLE COUNTY NO LEAD PROGRAM



The City of Wilmington provides a property tax exemption up to \$565.00 dollars per year to homeowners aged 65 and over who qualify based on income. Those that qualify also receive a discount on their water and sewer bills.
