WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY AWARDED LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARD CONTROL GRANT

On September 12, 2023, U.S. Senators Tom Carper and Chris Coons and Congresswoman Lisa Blunt Rochester (all D-Del.) announced a \$5 million grant to Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)'s Capital Fund Lead-Based Paint Program. WHA was one of 27 awardees of this competitive Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant that will help in the protection of children and families by identifying and eliminating lead-based paint hazards in public housing.

Each of the delegates expressed the importance of Delawareans, having access to safe and healthy homes. They are proud to have this HUD funding available for Wilmington families to improve health outcomes by removing the risk of lead poisoning in both children and adults. Senator Coons said, "I am proud to celebrate this federal grant that will make homes safer and healthier for low-income families and communities of color in Delaware that are disproportionately affected."

"American families deserve a safe and healthy place to call home. However, in many older homes, lead-based paint can be a serious threat to the health and well-being of children," said HUD Secretary Marcia Fudge. "This funding effort will help us identify homes where occupants are at risk of lead exposure and other health hazards, and build on our promise of a healthier, stronger country."

"The Wilmington Housing Authority is grateful to have the opportunity to receive this grant and make improvements to infrastructure that support some of our most vulnerable children and families. The grant will give the Wilmington Housing Authority the ability to expedite identifying and eliminating lead-based paint hazards much faster than we were previously able and will enhance our efforts to provide affordable and safe housing to the people we serve," said Wilmington Housing Authority Executive Director Ray Fitzgerald.

No smoking guidance include all residential units and all outdoor areas up to 25 feet from the Park View & Madison Gardens. Full guidance is provided in the Smoke Free Policy.





WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY HOMEOWNERSHIP PROGRAM

Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) offers two Homeownership Programs, Low-income Public Housing (LIPH) and Housing Choice Voucher (HCV), which provide Delaware residents with the opportunity become a first-time homebuyer. Both programs serve a wide range of households; low to moderate income, elderly, disabled, families (with or without children) and individuals.

Although LIPH and HCV are open to the same population, a difference in the program lies in the ownership of dwellings, where their homeownership journey begins in the rental phase. LIPH are properties owned and operated by WHA, while HCV is used with landlords other than WHA. Both programs also offer voluntary enrollment of participants in case management services through WHA's Resident Services

Department for guidance and support through their homeownership journey. LIPH participants have Resident Opportunities and Self-Sufficiency (ROSS), and HCV participants have Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) services. These services along with other portions of the homeownership journey is built out with partnerships of resources in the community such as Stand By Me, Meridian Bank and Exp Realty.

Another program opportunity through WHA's Homeownership Program is Section 32 Homeownership. This provides participants residing in WHA residences throughout the City of Wilmington the opportunity to have the First Right of Refusal to purchase the home before it becomes available to other qualifying participants or low-income residents of Wilmington.

Residence Services Chief, Irminia Brown-Williams stated that WHA Resident Services team intensely works with participants to ensure they are ready for successful Homeownership, so participants do not experience being mortgage poor. Since 2010 WHA has had zero foreclosures and more than ninety participants become homeowners.



WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY HOSTS EMPOWERMENT FAIR FOR FIRST TIME SINCE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

On August 18, 2023, Wilmington Housing Authority hosted their annual Empowerment Fair. The fair is designed to connect WHA residents to resources and services to support them in achieving their goals. Residents, WHA staff members, community members, as well as community and business partners were onsite to connect and fellowship.

This is the first year that WHA has been able to host the Empowerment Fair since the COVID-19 Pandemic. "This was my first time attending an Empowerment Fair and I thought it was absolutely wonderful!" stated WHA Resident Services Coordinator, Jamila Jones. "There were so many different vendors present to offer information and resource connections for WHA residents."






