
CELEBRATE US WORKFORCE TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

Celebrate Us Workforce Training has expanded their workforce training offerings for Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) residents, YouthBuild and the general public. In addition to the first career path of the 16-week Certified Central Sterile Processing Technician course; two Bridge Programs are now available:

- ① Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) to Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) Certification
- ② Pharmacy Technician to Pharmacist

CNA to LPN Certification

In January 2023, seven people began their 6-week CNA to LPN career path certification training. *Celebrate Us* also offers Licensed Healthcare Professionals the opportunity to enroll in an LPN Residency Program in partnership with ChristianaCare and Bayada Home Health Care. Additionally, for those that would like to transition beside nursing careers, a Medical Billing and Coding/Revenue Cycle Analyst Program is available.



Pharmacy Technician to Pharmacist Program

Pharmacy Technician to Pharmacist is a six-week workforce training program. The first four weeks of the program consists of on-line training. The last two weeks of the program is hands-on with a Patient Experience Technician and Study Buddy Mentors with former and current Pharmacy Technician/Pharmacist. 





NEW TAX DEDUCTIONS FOR DELAWAREANS

Delawareans who save for school with the DE529 Education Savings Plan may qualify for a new tax deduction on their state returns. Tax filers are now eligible to deduct up to \$1,000 of contributions to DE529 Education Savings Plans each year on their Delaware tax return (or \$2,000 for joint returns) with a few additional conditions.

Those contributing to a DEPENDABLE account for people with disabilities may qualify for a deduction as well. The deduction applies to any amount up to \$5,000 (\$10,000 for couples filing a joint return).

Those without a DE529 Education Savings Plan or DEPENDABLE account can take advantage of the tax deductions by opening accounts today at [529.delaware.gov](https://www.delaware.gov) or [able.delaware.gov](https://www.able.delaware.gov).

MOBILE IDENTIFICATION

Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) offers a mobile identification (MiD) App that can be downloaded to a smart phone. Mobile identification provides a convenient, safe and secure option to provide identification for verification both in person and electronically.

MiD is a companion to your physical ID rather than a replacement. You can use it in any context you would normally use your driver license or identification card to verify your identity, except when requested by law enforcement. You must still keep your physical ID as a back-up.
