WILMINGTON HOUSING AUTHORITY SIGNS AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE MORE HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR DELAWARE VOUCHER HOLDERS

On May 23, 2023, Wilmington Housing Authority, New Castle County Housing Authority, and Newark Housing Authority signed an Interagency Agreement to Facilitate Portability of HUD Voucher Recipients. The agreement will allow voucher holders in Newark, Wilmington, and New Castle County to use their vouchers in all three jurisdictions without any additional paperwork or applications.

"As we embark on expanding our partnerships, we'll be able to collaborate on some other things that will make the experience for the people who receive vouchers better and easier to navigate." stated WHA Executive Director, Ray Fitzgerald, "We hope to also make our landlords happier and more willing to participate because we're reducing barriers and creating more streamlined services." The agreement is a further step to reduce the barriers for Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) holders to find safe and affordable housing for themselves and their families.

WHA WELLNESS CHECKER PROGRAM

Wilmington Housing Authority (WHA) and the City of Wilmington have partnered for the Wellness Checker Pilot Program servicing WHA seniors and disabled residents. This one-year pilot program, scheduled to begin June 2023, is offered at five WHA high rises, Baynard, Crestview, Compton, Herlihy and Park View.

The Wellness Checker Program was developed to monitor the well-being of senior and disabled residents living alone daily through phone calls. Calls are prescheduled for specified hours from a Wellness Checker representative at a minimum of twice per week morning or evening. In addition to wellness check the calls provide companionship and support through conversation.

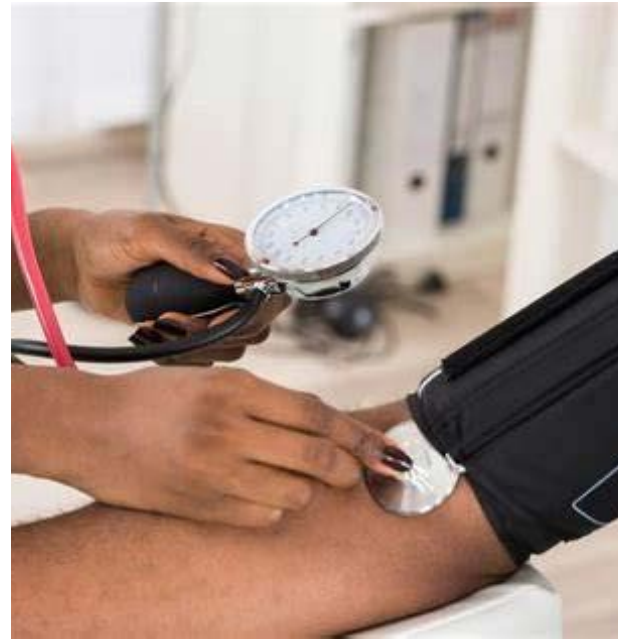
HEALTHY HEART AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

- A photo ID issued by the State of Delaware;
- A government-issued ID; OR
- A piece of printed mail or billing statement with a Delaware address.

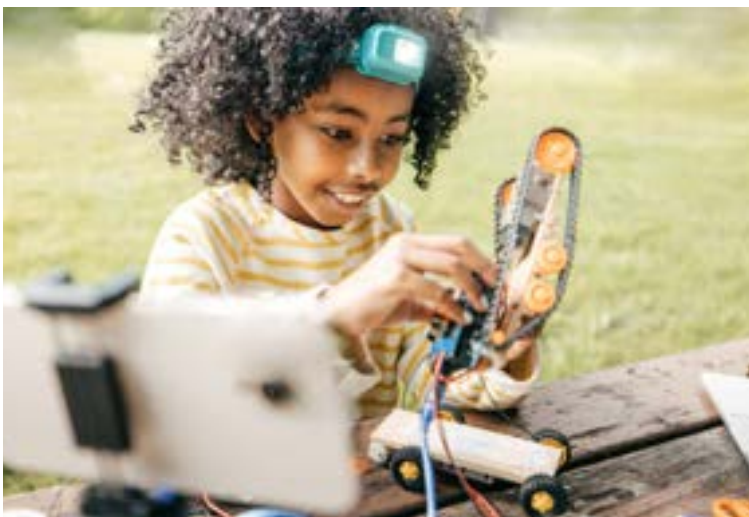
